The Adult School's High School ONLINE Summer School Program is designed for students who are credit deficient and/or who have failed a class required for graduation or college admission. Signups for all students are on a first-come, first-served basis **WITH SENIORS HAVING PRIORITY IN SESSIONS 1 AND 2.**

For all courses except Health: Credit for Online Summer School will ONLY be given to students repeating a course unless approved by an MVLA administrator. Once course is verified, students **must** register online at mvla.net/AS. Students under the age of 18 must submit this application signed by a parent prior to the mandatory orientation.

Registration for high school summer school classes begins on Wednesday March 20, 2019. Instructions for online registration are available at mvla.net/AS as well as with counseling staff at Mountain View, Los Altos, and Alta Vista High Schools. To ensure enrollment, students **must** register online **and** submit an application to their counselor **no later than Friday, May 24th.** Classes may be canceled without prior notice if enrollment is not sufficient. Confirmation of registration, class assignment, and an orientation reminder will be **e-mailed to the address associated with your online registration account.** **PLEASE NOTE: online summer school is self-paced; students will be able to drop-in for help and testing (at their convenience) during our Summer Lab hours: Monday-Friday, 9 am to 3 pm.** If there are any questions, please contact your counselor, visit mvla.net/AS for detailed information, or call the Adult School at 650-940-1333.

Only students who attend school in the Mountain View-Los Altos UHSD during the school year are eligible to enroll in the district's **online** summer school program. **In order to receive credit, all enrolled students are required to attend orientation, make regular progress in their coursework, AND visit the Adult School to take course tests and exams.** Students may also participate in supervised study and obtain academic assistance from teaching staff during our summer office hours at our Learning Lab (room 104), Mon. through Fri. 9am-3pm. Summer school is a privilege; therefore, students who violate district or Adult School rules (same as school year) will be dropped from summer school, receive no credit for work completed, and be susceptible to administrative consequences.
