Typical Existing Classroom Size 710 SF



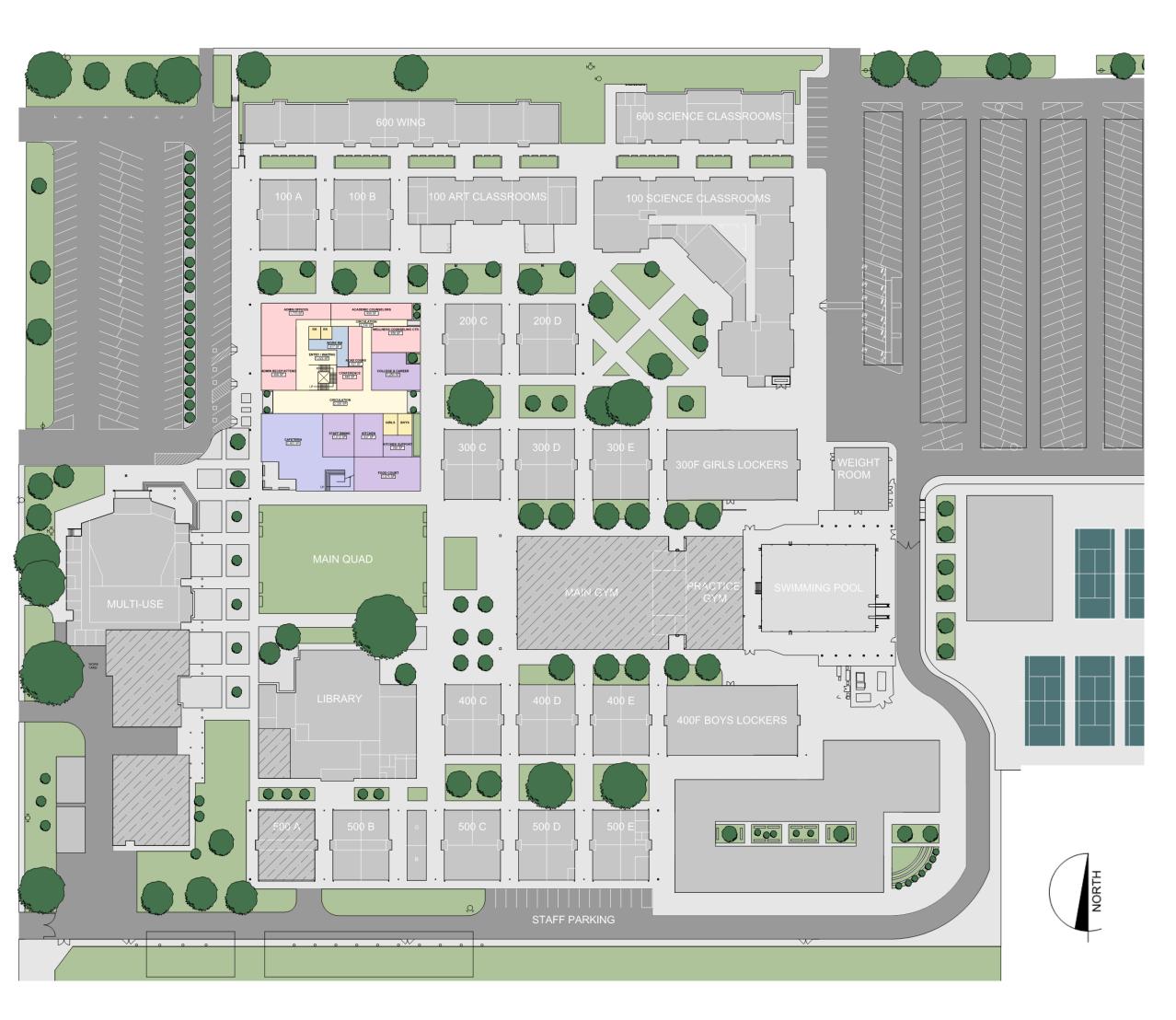
