Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Los Altos High School was required to operate entirely by distance learning during Spring, 2020 and opened in the Fall under the same conditions, with gradual return to in-seat learning per advice from the Health Department.

Los Altos High School (LAHS) is a comprehensive public high school (9-12) located in the heart of Silicon Valley, serving a diverse student body from both professional and working-class families. The Mountain View-Los Altos Union High School District consists of two high schools, a continuation high school and a number of alternative programs. Our attendance area includes highly affluent sections of Los Altos, Los Altos Hills and Mountain View as well as low-income housing sections of Mountain View. Newsweek ranked LAHS among the top 1% of high schools nationwide. Enrollment of 2,212 students includes 37% Caucasian, 28% Hispanic-Latino, 32% Asian and 3% other.* LAHS is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).

We are committed to the process of continuous learning and the application of knowledge. THE CURRICULUM - ACADEMIC PROGRAM

Los Altos High School offers a rigorous college preparatory program with wide selections of honors and AP classes as well as special education and support classes. The school operates on a modified block schedule with 50-minute class periods three days a week and 90-minute periods two days a week, plus a weekly Tutorial. We have an open access policy for admission to Honors/AP classes.
